NU RUSH OFFENSE VS. OKLAHOMA RUSH DEFENSE

Granted, it was against Iowa State and Baylor, but Nebraska has averaged 190.5 yards the past two weeks with five rushing TDs. RB Marlon Lucky has been effective and RB Quentin Castille has added a change of pace, although Castille's fumbling should be a concern. Oklahoma allows only 3.1 yards a carry, and five of eight opponents haven't made it past 102 yards.

Advantage: Oklahoma

NU PASS OFFENSE VS. OKLAHOMA PASS DEFENSE

Oklahoma gave up 478 yards and three touchdowns last week to Kansas State QB Josh Freeman, although OU's 55-point first half put the game away early. NU has a better attack than K-State, with QB Joe Ganz completing 70 percent of his passes and accounting for 287.9 yards per game. The Huskers have passed for 357, 328 and 336 yards the last three weeks.

Advantage: Nebraska

OKLAHOMA RUSH OFFENSE VS. NU RUSH DEFENSE

Both Chris Brown and DeMarco Murray went over 100 yards vs. K-State, and both rank among the Big 12's top five rushers. They operate behind one of the nation's best lines, anchored on the left side by 6-foot-8, 337-pound Phil Loadholt and 6-5, 335-pound Duke Robinson. If the Sooners win the line of scrimmage, the absence of MLB Phillip Dillard will only be further exposed.

Advantage: Oklahoma

OKLAHOMA PASS OFFENSE VS. NU PASS DEFENSE

Don't feel bad if it happens, Huskers, because QB Sam Bradford victimizes just about every opponent. The sophomore is building Heisman credentials, and already has 65 TD passes in 22 career games. Seven of those this season have exceeded 50 yards. Generating pressure will be an issue for Nebraska, since OU has allowed just eight sacks. The Sooners also have TE Jermaine Gresham, who is NFL-caliber.

Advantage: Oklahoma

SPECIAL TEAMS

NU improved its punting against Baylor but missed an extra point and had a field goal blocked. Oklahoma P Mike Knall is averaging just 35.0, but that stat is affected by where he's often kicking from. OU gave up some return punch when it lost Reggie Smith, but has decent numbers. Big knock on the Sooners is the kickoff returns of 97 yards by Cincinnati and 96 by Texas.

Advantage: Nebraska

OUR TAKE: Other than the mini-revival in 2000 and 2001, this proud series has been marred by mismatches one way or the other the last 15 years or so. The oddsmakers predict this will be another, making Oklahoma a three-touchdown favorite. Nebraska can look at OU's defensive cracks and see hope, but it might not matter if NU can't get the Sooners' offense off the field. This is the Huskers' third road game in four weeks, and they probably don't have the depth or manpower to go 12 rounds with OU. — **Rich Kaipust**
