## NU-Texas Tech matchups

### NU RUSH OFFENSE VS. TEXAS TECH RUSH DEFENSE

It's the same old story this week for the Huskers, who still haven't established a legitimate running game. They'll likely try to run it again this week, hoping to keep Texas Tech's offense off the field. But during the last two weeks, 78 percent of NU's 134 rushing yards have come in the second half. By that time, the Red Raiders could be cruising.

### NU PASS OFFENSE VS. TEXAS TECH PASS DEFENSE

Teams playing Texas Tech tend to throw the ball more just to keep up. That could be a good thing for QB Joe Ganz, who struggled to lead the Husker offense early on vs. Missouri. He threw just one interception, but was noticeably gloomy when he assessed his performance. Tech, with a schedule that's featured two Division I-AA teams, has allowed an average of 233.4 passing

yards per game.

**Advantage:** Nebraska

### TEXAS TECH RUSH OFFENSE VS. NU RUSH DEFENSE

Red Raider RBs Baron Batch and Shannon Woods have combined to average 130.6 yards per game on the ground, providing an adequate change of pace for a team known for its preference to pass. Last week, Nebraska was so focused on slowing the

pass portion of Missouri's spread offense that it seemed to forget that the Tigers might hand the ball off. NU gave up an average of 5.9 rushing yards per carry.

**Advantage:** Texas Tech

### TEXAS TECH PASS OFFENSE VS. NU PASS DEFENSE

Texas Tech has the nation's best passing offense for a reason. An experienced quarterback, Graham Harrell, can effectively

distribute passes to a group of talented receivers, headlined by Michael Crabtree. The offensive line has allowed just one sack despite the team passing the ball 262 times. NU's pass defense, a mess against Mizzou, might not have enough time to fix all the errors.

**Advantage:** Texas Tech

It might be good for the Huskers to take a trip and play football outside of Memorial Stadium, where the pressure to perform seems overwhelming sometimes. But Texas Tech, desperately seeking some national respect, won't do Nebraska any favors. Even if the game gets out of hand, coach Mike Leach has a tendency to stick to his pass-first philosophy. Leach's Red Raiders put up 58 points against Kansas State last week. So far this season, Nebraska hasn't shown enough offensive firepower to match what it'll face today. — **Jon Nyatawa**
